

## **DRUG TESTING AND EDUCATION PROGRAM**

The Prosser School Board of Directors, administration, athletic department, coaches, club/activity advisors, and instructional staff support a drug-free environment for all who participate in our extracurricular programs. The Prosser School District offers a voluntary random Drug Testing and Education Program (DTEP) for those involved in extracurricular activities, as a community-based commitment to help our students remain drug-free. Parents and school personnel must work together in order to attain a safe, orderly, and drug-free school environment. The School Board recognizes that the misuse of drugs is a serious problem with legal, physical and social implications for the entire school community. As an educational institution of this community, the school district strives to prevent drug abuse and help drug abusers by educational, rather than punitive, means.
